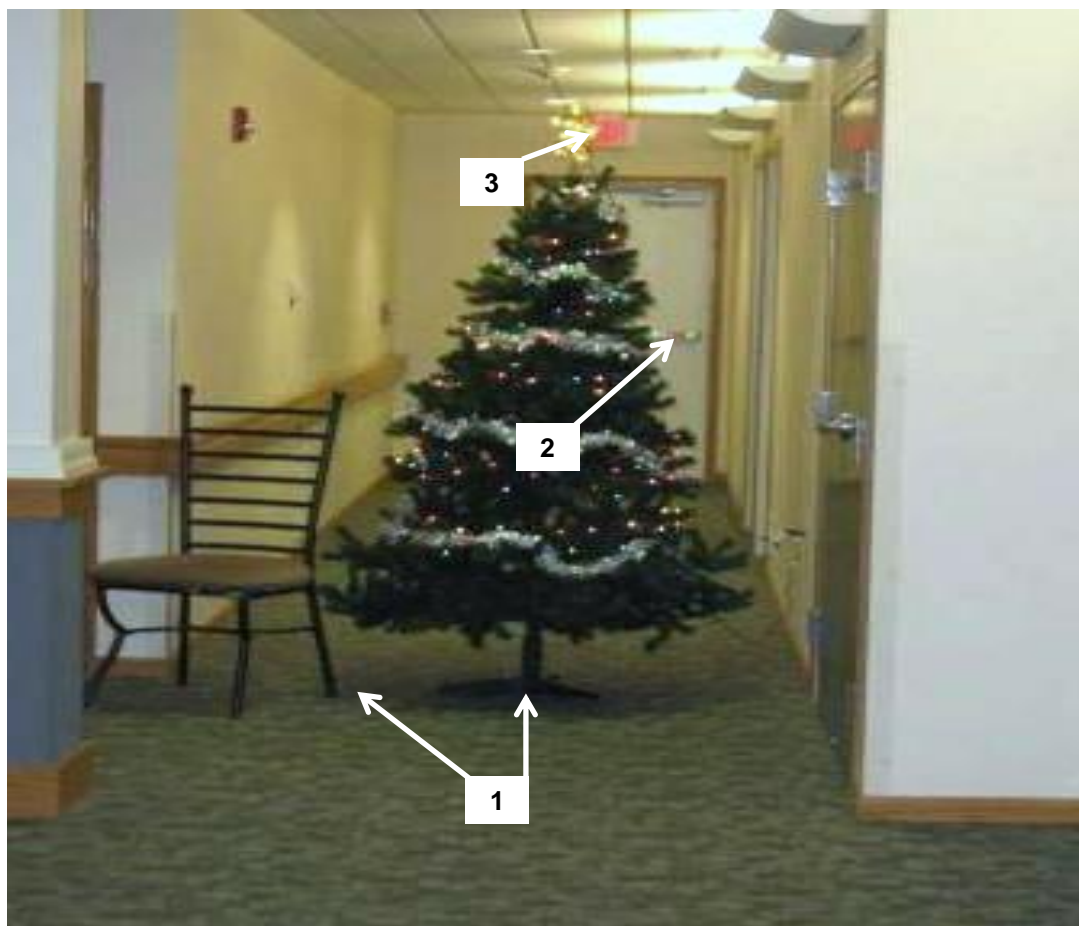




## CAN YOU IDENTIFY THE HAZARDS?

1. Exit routes must be free and unobstructed. By placing the Christmas tree and the chair in the hallway, this blocks the exit route and also creates a trip and fall hazard.
2. The visibility of the exit route door is compromised by the Christmas tree. All exit routes must be free of furnishings or decorations that obscure the visibility of the exit route door.
3. The line of sight to the exit sign is blocked by the Christmas tree. Exit signs must be clearly visible at all times
